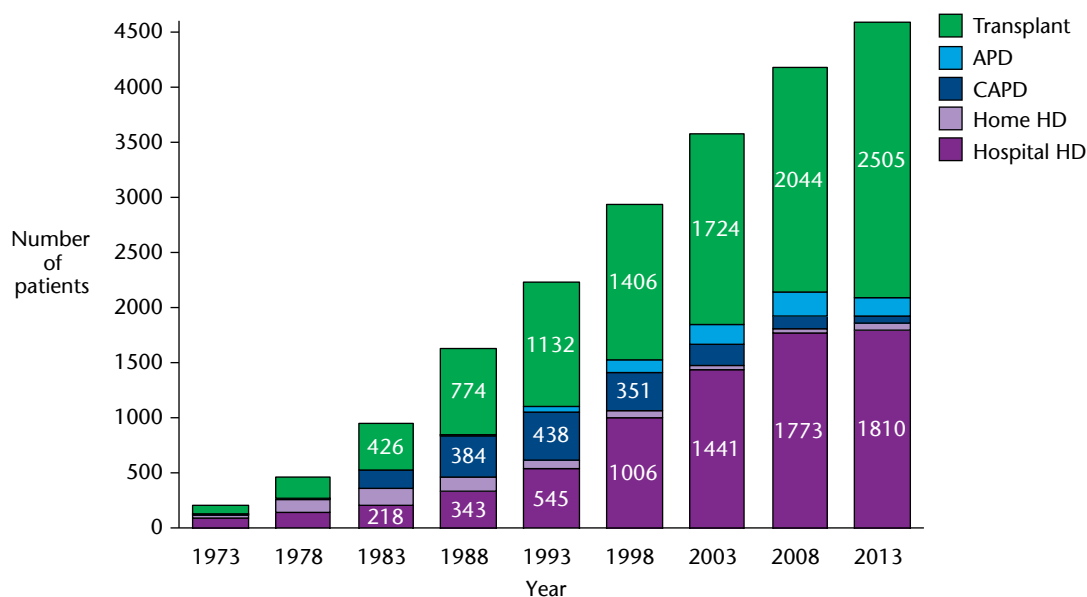

B1 Patients receiving RRT in Scotland according to modality of treatment on 31 December

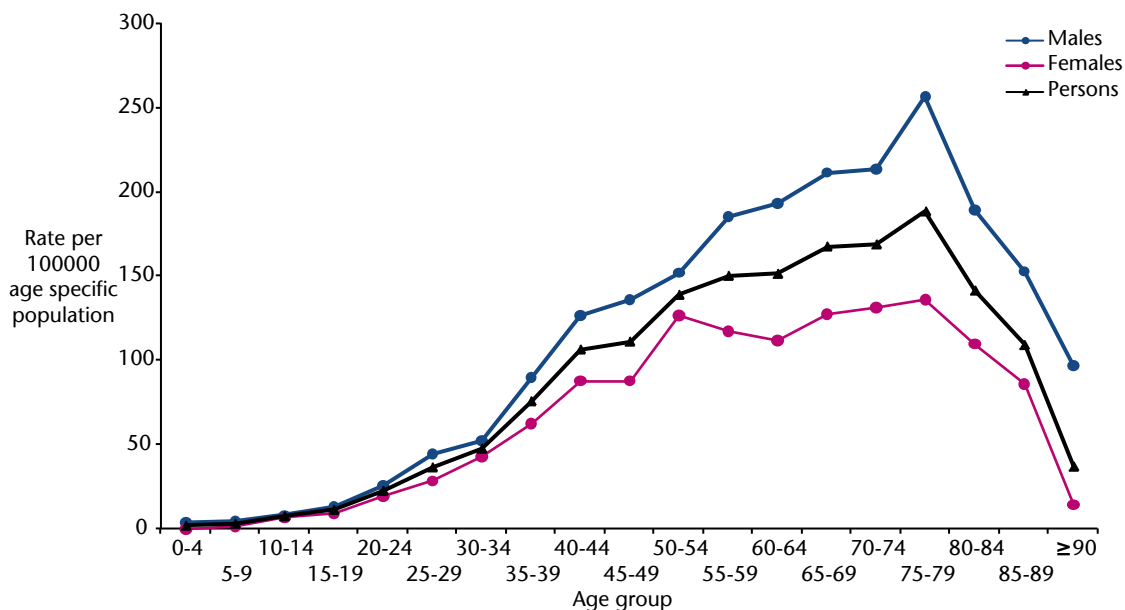
B1.1 Prevalent patients every fifth year between 1973-2013



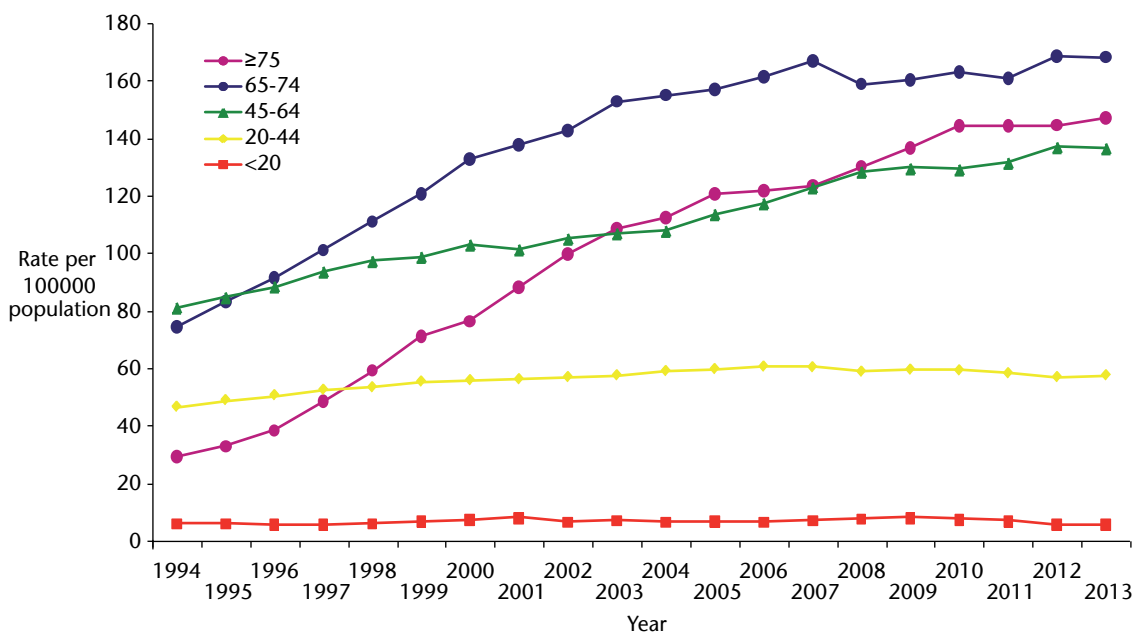

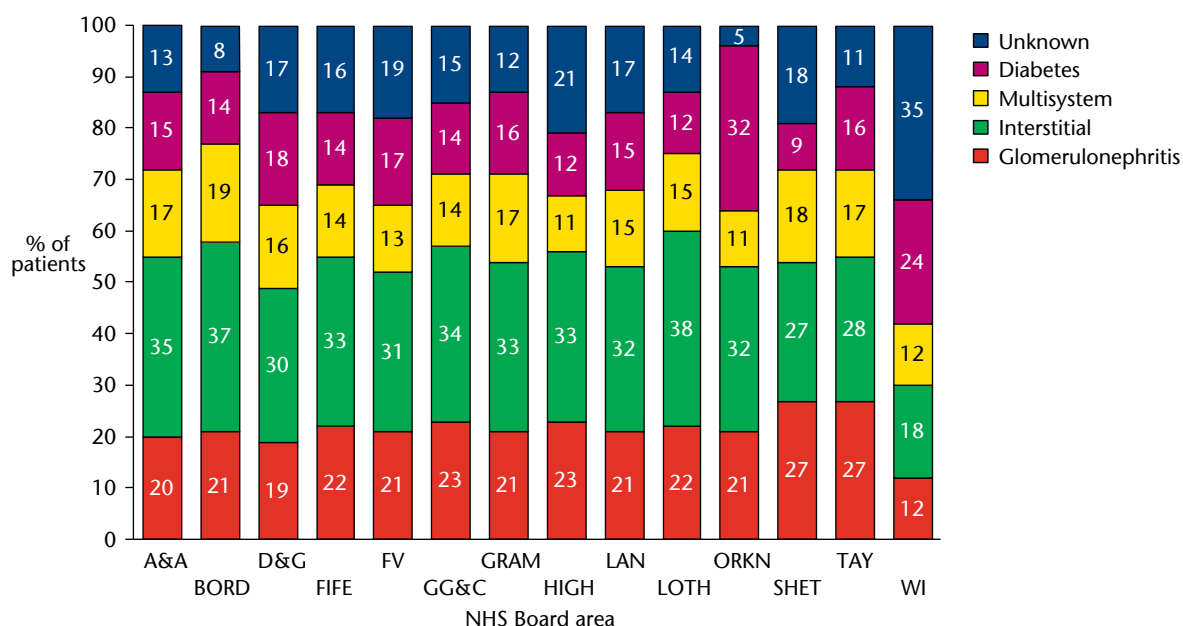
